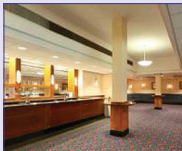

Christopher Garnett is a Board Member of the Olympic Delivery Authority and Chairman of the Olympic and Paralympic Transport Board, which is charged with providing overall assurance that transport will be successfully delivered during the 2012 Games.



A Board Member of Transport for London and chair to the Rail Panel, Christopher is also a non executive Director of Anglian Water Services Ltd and Aggregate Industries Ltd. In 2006 he retired after 10 years as Chairman and Chief Executive of GNER. Prior to that he had been Commercial Director of Eurotunnel at the time of the opening of the Channel Tunnel. Earlier he had worked for Sealink British Ferries operating Cross Channel ferries. Christopher is also a member of the advisory board of the National Railway Museum and a Trustee of the Windsor Leadership Trust.

Professor Dr Remko van Hoek is a world renowned authority on logistics and supply chain management. He has been honored with the coveted GDF Suez Purchasing Trophy and the Procurecon Award for Change Management and Innovation.

During his distinguished career, Remko has won no less than 10 academic awards. He serves on the Board of Directors of the Council for Supply Chain Management Professionals in the US and the Advisory Board of Procurement Leaders in the UK.
